## AFFIDAVIT

Detective Rick VanKeuren, makes this affidavit in support of application for a search and seizure for the packages described as One JVC "Everio" video Camera Serial number 123G1223 and one JVC "Everio" video Camera Serial number 152B2198 being stored as evidence at the Yuma District Office of the Arizona Highway Patrol located at 2111 E. Gila Ridge Road in Yuma Arizona.

I, Detective Rick VanKeuren, am a detective assigned to the Criminal Investigation Division of the Arizona Department of Public Safety. I am currently detailed and assigned as a Task Force member to the United States Drug Enforcement Administration at the Yuma Resident Office. I have been employed as an officer for 11 years. Prior to employment as an Arizona Law Enforcement Officer I was enlisted in the United States Marine Corps for 6 years. I was assigned as a Military Police Explosives/Narcotics dog handler/supervisor and achieved the rank of Sergeant.

I have received training in the identification, uses, concealment, sales, transportation, smuggling and current trends and practices in Cocaine, Marijuana, Methamphetamine, Heroin, and Extacy. I have participated in both simple and complex, local, national, and international investigations. I have participated in undercover operations and have made numerous drug and fraud related arrests/seizures. I have been involved in numerous criminal investigations and have had successful prosecutions relating to thefts, fraud, forgery, identity theft, narcotics related offenses, sex crimes, assaults, and murder. I have investigated murders, assaults, thefts, computer crimes, and sex crimes. I have received training in the identification of fraudulent identifications, documents, and counterfeit United States currency. I have further received training in human smuggling and child exploitation. I have participated in, wrote, and executed numerous search warrants for the above mentioned crimes. These search warrants, assisted with the prosecution of those crimes. I have interviewed suspects of the afore mentioned crimes and questioned them regarding their methods for the purpose of developing an understanding of how these crimes are committed. I have further instructed both line serving officers and basic recruits on investigating these crimes.

On April 14, 2009, Officer M. R. Jones #2819 of the Arizona Department of Public Safety, was called to the United States Border Patrol to assist them with an individual that had locked and barricaded himself in his vehicle, was refusing to follow commands, and was blocking the number two lane of Interstate 8 at milepost 78 eastbound. On arrival Officer Jones met with Border Patrol Agent (BPA) Spoonamore. Agent Spoonamore informed Officer Jones that he was working the pre-inspection area of the checkpoint with his canine partner "Jerry C". As a red Hyundai entered the primary inspection area "Jerry C" showed an alert to the vehicle for the possible presence of narcotics or a concealed person. Agent Spoonamore informed the agent at the contact area, BPA Gomez, that there was an alert and instructed him to send the vehicle to the secondary inspection area for a more detailed contact.

As BPA Gomez explained that the canine in the pre-inspection area had alerted to his vehicle and asked the driver to move his vehicle into the secondary inspection area. The driver refused, and started yelling at the agents that they had no authority to search his vehicle without a warrant. Agents then said that the driver took out a video camera and began filming. Officer Jones feared that the driver might flee or be impaired so stop sticks were placed in front of the tires of the vehicle and Officer Jones placed his State owned patrol vehicle behind the Hyundai SUV. Officer Jones attempted to speak with the driver by first identifying himself as an Arizona Highway Patrol Officer and then asking to speak with him. The driver only lowered his window down approximately 1/2 inches, refused to directly speak to Officer Jones and then asked if he could leave. Officer Jones noted that the driver was filming with his video camera and was pointing it in his direction during this time. Officer Jones tried to explain to the driver that a canine had alerted to his vehicle and because of this canine alert, officers and agents had probable cause to search the vehicle. To try to help defuse the situation, Officer Jones asked BPA Spoonamore if he could again run his canine partner around the vehicle. As normal procedure for canine alerts at the checkpoints, a secondary run of a canine is done in the secondary inspection area and BPA Spoonamore asked if they could handle this in the secondary area instead.

The driver again asked Officer Jones if he was free to leave. Officer Jones told the driver that he was not free to leave and that he was now under arrest for blocking a highway and resisting a lawful order of a law enforcement officer. Officer Jones then read the driver his Miranda warnings from a department issued card at 2300 hours. Officer Jones informed the driver that he should exit the vehicle and that he was going to have to eventually. Officer Jones then noted that the driver began to have a blank stare forward and was refusing to now speak with him rolling up his window again. Officer J. Mitchell #3473 of the Arizona Department of Public Safety then arrived. Officers Jones and Mitchell believed that possibly a fresh face or different person trying to speak with the driver would resolve the situation peacefully and without the use of force.

Officer Mitchell also identified himself and asked the driver if he recognized him as a law enforcement officer. The driver acknowledged Officer Mitchell and said that he did recognize him as a law enforcement officer rolling his window down about 3/4 of an inch. Officer Mitchell asked the driver if there was any medical reason that would

prevent him from exiting his vehicle and the driver replied, "No". Officer Mitchell asked the driver to exit his vehicle to which he refused. Officer Mitchell also explained to the driver that he was under arrest for obstructing a public thoroughfare and for failing to obey a lawful order. From the initial start of the contact with the driver to the point that Officer Mitchell again advised the driver that he was under arrest over one hour had elapsed.

Officers Mitchell and Jones obtained authorization from Highway Patrol District Commander Lieutenant George Anderson #4451 to break out the window of the Hyundai SUV and arrest the driver. The DPS officers and Border Patrol agents formulated a plan to enter the vehicle for the safety of all involved. The driver was warned to shield his eyes because they were now forced to break his window to arrest him. Officer Mitchell broke a hole in the passenger side window and utilized his Taser to immobilize the driver while Border Patrol Agents broke out the driver's side window to gain access to the driver's side locks to extricate the driver. The driver was removed from the vehicle and arrested without further incident. The driver was finally fully identified as Mr. STEVEN LEE ANDERSON by a valid Arizona driver's license.

It should be noted that this detective has further learned that STEVEN LEE ANDERSON has had previous contact with U. S. Border Patrol inspection stations and other law enforcement agencies in other states in New Mexico and Minnesota and has acted or behaved in a similar manner. Specifically under You-Tube blogs "Abusive Border Patrol agents w/ nun chucks at NM checkpoint" <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=kfs7oZtk8Ks&feature=channel>, "Polic eman with a machinegun harasses US citizens at PHX airport" <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=5cD2BCBaNaM&feature=related>, "Another cop harasses me for ABSOLUTELY NO REASON \*Minnesota" <http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=6reRAQLGRqI>.

Your affiant believes that evidence of the events depicted above are being stored in the two video cameras. Numerous officers and agents on scene witnessed the STEVEN LEE ANDERSON operating the camera during the course of this encounter. I respectfully requests that this warrant be granted for: One JVC "Everio" video Camera Serial number 123G1223 and one JVC "Everio" video Camera Serial number 152B2198 being stored as evidence at the Yuma District Office of the Arizona Highway Patrol located at 2111 E. Gila Ridge Road in Yuma Arizona.
